INTRODUCTION

It takes a lot to operate the Lutheran Camping Corporation – cabins, retreat lodges, pools, program equipment, sufficient funds, vans, tractors and tools, summer and year round staff, and more. However, that stuff is not the essence of the LCC's ministry. The ministry of the LCC focuses on the people of God: how they encounter God through outdoor ministries, and how they respond to God's gracious love when they return to their homes and congregations. Through our unique offerings of summer camp, family camp, retreat ministry, day camps, and rental of our facilities, Christ was made known to everyone who participated in and supported this ministry in the past year.

All that we do at Kirchenwald, Nawakwa, and The Wittel Farm is an extension of the ministries of the Lower Susquehanna Synod congregations we serve. KIRCHENWALD

A sower went out to sow his seed; and as he sowed, some fell on the path and was trampled on, and the birds of the air ate it up. Some fell on the rock; and as it grew up, it withered for lack of moisture. Some fell among the thorns, and the thorns grew with it and choked it. Some fell into good soil, and when it grew, it produced a hundredfold. - Luke 8:5-8



In the garden at Kirchenwald we have a row of pole beans. In order to grow a healthy harvest of pole beans, you need to first till and rake the soil, removing rocks and other debris that may interfere with your plant growing to its full potential. Then plant your seeds. Build a trellis (these are often teepee shaped) and stake it into the ground above your seeds to support the vines of your crop as it grows. Surround your plant with a mulch or compost mix to provide nutrients as it sprouts from the earth. You'll need to water it regularly, especially in those times when rain is sparse. Get down on your knees and pluck the weeds that might otherwise deprive your pole beans of important sunlight and nutrients. It also helps to keep your garden looking beautiful. In a few weeks, your vines should be producing an abundant harvest of healthy beans. It may take a lot of work, but the results are well worth the effort.

Camp can be a lot like that. It's a place where the seeds of those Christian values that have been planted at home and at church are tended and cultivated. It's a place where new seeds are sown as well. Through games, conversation, and learning new skills, we find support in the caring Christ-centered community of camp, allowing us to grow and blossom in our faith. It's a place where the evidence of God's abundant love and grace surround us - in the beauty of His creation and in the people we meet.

"Keeping the Earth" was a theme this past summer that encouraged us all to get a little dirt under our fingernails as we explored what it meant to be stewards of God's creation. The thirty-nine staff and over thirty volunteers at Kirchenwald worked to nurture the faith lives of 513 campers this summer, and we hope to see that population grow in the upcoming season.

We're thankful to all of you who help to sow the seeds of Christian community through your time, talents, and donations to the ministry at Kirchenwald. Your gifts continue to support the important work being done at camp, rooted in the proclamation of the Good News!

“My hope for you is the reviving of your faith, the strengthening of your convictions, and of your determination to go forward in the service of Christ...”

These are the words of John D. Foerster, written in 1940 to the Nawakwa Alumni Association. Seventy years later, we hope the same things for the Nawakwa campers of this generation – and these are lofty aspirations.

To think that Nawakwa, a camp serving children, adults, and families, could have such an effect on people that they would leave this place revived, strengthened, and ready to serve Jesus seems like a long shot. A quick glance at our programs in operation might reveal loud songs, boisterous games, and ridiculous skits. How could these methods possibly revive, strengthen, and encourage people to proclaim the Good News in word and deed?

We see the results of Nawakwa’s ministry, from our beginnings in 1929 to today, throughout the church. Our campers have gone on to become bishops and pastors, rostered lay leaders, teachers, chaplains, and faithful members of congregations throughout the world.

Thank you for being so generous with your gifts to further the ministry of Nawakwa so that we might continue to make Pastor Foerster’s hope a reality.

The Wittel Farm occupies a unique niche in the ministry of the LCC. The farmhouse, known as the House of Prayer, is an ideal site for individuals and small groups seeking a quiet, peaceful place to experience God's presence. It is the LCC's most comfortably appointed retreat facility and is also a great place for a family get-away.

The LCC conducts day-long retreats, including the Advent and Lenten Days Apart and the monthly Bishop's Bible Study Days at Wittel. The farm is also frequently used by others to enjoy quiet reflection in the gardens, to walk the Trail of the Resurrection, or to utilize the Labyrinth for prayer and devotions. Faith on the Farm was the 2010 Summer Day Program, which was enjoyed by 62 children from local Lutheran congregations. The 2011 Summer Day Program is Faith in the Wilderness. It will be an exciting, hands-on Christian education experience that brings well know Bible heroes to life for kids in unexpected ways.

One of our campers wrote that he was surprised to discover that learning about God was fun. It usually doesn't take long for our campers (of all ages) to realize this fact. During games, hikes, evening worship, singing, cookouts, swimming, skits, devotions, sailing – with friends old and new, with counselors and staff who love the Lord-God becomes very real in the outdoor world of Lutheran camping.

As wonderful as our ministry is, it could not happen without the generous support of scores of congregations and thousands of generous and talented individuals.

In 2010 we received monetary gifts from 94 congregations and 477 individuals/families.

72 golfers participated in our 11th Annual Golf Tournament. With the charitable portion of their fees, and the individual, corporate, and charitable sponsors, the tournament raised \$13,260 for our campership fund.

Thirty-three individuals, 6 church groups, and 3 business made donations of gifts-in-kind to our 6th Annual Quilt/Handicraft Auction in November resulting in a total of \$6,093 to be added to the Endowment fund.

We received \$80,000 from the Lower Susquehanna Synod of the ELCA.

We received grants from the Robert C. Hoffman Charitable Trust, the Golfers Charitable Association, and the Gettysburg Rotary Club. We received monetary gifts or gifts-in-kind from 23 businesses.

89 members of Thrivent Financial for Lutherans designated \$6,729.00 to support Lutheran Camping Corporation ministries in this first year of the Thrivent Choice program. All eleven Thrivent Financial for Lutherans local chapters in the Lower Susquehanna Synod supported us with grants in the Care Abounds in Communities program for either fundraising and/or Hands On Service projects.

We received thousands of hours of volunteer labor in a variety of categories, from our camp nurses to chaplains, musicians and carpenters, envelope stuffers to letter writers, to name just a few.

You will find lists of financial contributions designated for particular parts of the ministry of the LCC on the related pages of this report.

These gifts of time, creativity, energy, enthusiasm and money result in lively and gifted Christian disciples! Campers who benefit from their time at Kirchenwald, Nawakwa, and The Wittel Farm, return to their families, churches and communities, taking with them the love of God to share wherever they go. Thank God for this abundant grace!
