Top 10 Ways to Promote Camping in Your Congregation

- 10. Invite someone from the Lutheran Camping Corporation to make a presentation at your church... they'll sing, they'll preach, they'll play fun action games with the kids, they'll do almost anything to promote camp.
- 9. Use the promotional videos located on the website and social media pages. Share the videos to your congregation's social media sites.
- 8. Have a Camping Sunday! Invite campers to wear their Kirchenwald and Nawakwa clothing. Make a display with photographs, camp crafts, and nature-y items.
- 7. Feature a former camper(s) and ask them to tell a story or teach a song they learned at camp ... this makes a great Temple Talk.
- 6. Create a camping bulletin board highlighting summer camp and other opportunities. (You can use the brochure as well as photographs and drawings from campers.)
- 5. Remind parents that when kids are at camp, the refrigerator door is opened 47% less often.
- 4. Create a display using a tent, a Christmas tree, stuffed animals, sleeping bag, Bible, flashlight, etc. Keep the Camping Brochures nearby.
- 3. Suggest giving a week of summer camp as a birthday or Christmas gift.
- 2. Tell EVERYONE of the many ways camp contributes to the faith formation of people of every age group.
- 1. Remind parents that a week with kids at camp is a peaceful week at home alone for them.
