

It's likely that thirty years from now, school children will be interviewing us on what it was like to live through the pandemic. If there's one thing our 2021 summer camp curriculum taught us, it's that, through all of time and for all people, God has been a constant - From Generation to Generation. In both times of joy and times of sorrow, and through growth and decline, God's steadfast love endures forever.

Scripture reminds us that God enters into covenants with humankind and that God's promises made to our ancestors are still alive for us today. Reflecting on this truth, it's easy to make the connection to the generations of campers who have played, made friends, and grown in their faith at Kirchenwald. Our thanks goes out to the 30 volunteers and 28 staff who committed themselves to ministry over the summer.

Thanks to all who contributed to the success of Kirchenwald's summer program over the years. We are bound together in experiences, friendships, and the love of God through all generations.

That verse is relevant to all aspects of life and the lessons our staff and other leaders strive to impart to our campers. Our outdoor ministry strives to serve with love, and the programs we offer strive to make the world a better place.

As wonderful as our ministry is, it could not happen without the generous support of the many congregations and thousands of generous and talented individuals. In 2021:

- 72 congregations and 632 individuals made monetary contributions in support of LCC ministries.
- 41 individuals and 23 churches donated quilts or craft items to make the Quilt and Craft Auction a success, raising \$12,740.
- The Lower Susquehanna Synod provide \$66,500 in financial support.
- Volunteers gave time, energy, and expertise in various capacities, including as camp nurses, musicians, chaplains, kitchen helpers, vegetable growers, and maintenance workers.
- Thanks to Thrivent, a generous ministry partner, 74 Thrivent members directed \$17,103 to LCC through Thrivent Choice. Other Thrivent members created Action Teams with various projects benefiting the ministry.
- \$13,518 in Campership donations helped children attend camp who would be unable to attend this joyful and faith-building ministry due to financial hardship.
- Generous financial support helped keep facilities attractive, safe, and user-friendly, and enabled significant ministry site improvements.
