# Nawakwa Craft Retreat

You are welcome to pick and choose from our projects or bring your own projects to complete. Workspace (particularly table space) is limited for individual projects, but we will try to accommodate your needs if possible. There is a suggested supply list on page 2 but most everything you need will be provided for you. If you have a special skill or craft that you would like to share, please let me know. We always welcome your participation!

Here are some details to help you prepare for the weekend:

- Directions to Nawakwa are included with this letter but can also be found at [LutheranCamping.org](http://LutheranCamping.org)
- Friday night registration will be held in the kitchen area of Zinn Tozer Lodge (the first lodge on your left after you turn into Camp Nawakwa) beginning at **5:00 p.m.** The first gathering for everyone will begin at **7:00 p.m.**
- A Thursday night option is available for an additional \$40. (More info is located below.)
- Housing for the weekend will be in the various lodges of Nawakwa.
- Please bring your own sheets or sleeping bag plus pillows, towels, toiletries, etc.
- Large group meetings will occur in Zinn-Tozer Lodge.
- We invite you to bring a snack to share for the weekend if you are able.
- The phone number for Camp Nawakwa is (717) 677-8211. During the weekend, there is an automated telephone system that will guide callers to reach specific areas of camp. Lodges are: Zinn Tozer, Brennaman, & Grove. We will share meals and work on some crafts in the Dining Hall (particularly painting).
- Cell phone coverage is limited at Nawakwa.
- The schedule will include specific times for crafting but also free time to relax and hike.
- Each day will include devotions and conclude with time for prayer and worship.

- Please contact me if you will arrive late so that we will not worry about you!
- Craft Weekend will conclude by 1:00 p.m. on Sunday. I look forward to seeing you in November. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.

### **PS. Thursday Evening info!!!**

Everyone is invited to arrive a day early to work on your own projects, spend time hiking, relaxing or even sleeping. If you would like to have an extra night at Nawakwa, this is for you! I will arrive by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday and will be in Zinn-Tozer Lodge to check you in and give you your weekend housing assignment. The weekend craft projects, devotions and meals will not be offered until 7 p.m. on Friday evening so meals on Thursday and Friday will be on our own so please bring your own food or money for purchasing food (sometimes we choose to go out for a meal). **The extra cost for Thursday evening is \$40 (No food included or provided).** Please reserve your spot for Thursday by indicating on your registration form or contacting Nawakwa by email or phone.

Each crafter who wishes to make a Patio Crock Lantern should **Purchase the size crock / clay flower pot of their choice.** You will also need a **2 oz bottle of Enamel Paint of your choice** for base coat background to be painted **Friday night ( at least 2 coats)** to cover so it is very dry and cured by Saturday morning when we will add the whimsical floral designs. Samples are pictured:

Blue 3 1/2 inch base w/ 6 inch opening  
 Red is 4 1/2 inch base w/ 7 1/2 inch opening  
 Green is larger.

You will also need to purchase the solar lights.



Mini gourds and paint will be provided. Each crafter will have the opportunity to decorate a gourd basket with their own design.



Card to paint with acrylics.

### Suggested Supplies to Bring:

- ☐ Scissors for cutting different projects. If you plan to do any paper crafts bring your favorite paper scissors. Be sure to put your name on your scissors.
- ☐ Paint brushes will be provided but it is always nice to paint with your own so feel free to bring them.
- ☐ Be sure to purchase the enamel paint described for the flower pot solar light holder in the color of your choice. Paints for the accents will be provided.
- ☐ Paint for the gourds and card will be provided. If there is a special color you like, feel free to bring it.

## **Directions to Camp Nawakwa:**

The physical address for Nawakwa is: 1033 Nawakwa Road, Biglerville, PA 17307

***From Harrisburg:*** Take Rt. 83 South to Rt. 581 West; exit onto Rt. 15 South toward Gettysburg. Exit onto Rt. 234 West (a right turn) and follow through Biglerville.\*

***From the Pennsylvania Turnpike:*** Exit at Exit 17 and go south on Route 15 towards Gettysburg. Exit onto Route 234 West (a right turn) and follow through Biglerville.\*

***From Carlisle:*** Take Rt. 34 South to Biglerville; turn right onto Rt. 234 West.\*

***From Lancaster and York:*** Take Rt. 30 West through York. Just beyond West York, make a right onto Salem Church Road (look for a large Rutter's Market at the traffic signal); follow to Rt. 234 (approx. 1.5 miles). Turn left on to Rt. 234 West and follow through Biglerville.\*

\*Approximately 1.5 miles beyond Biglerville, watch for a 3 way stop. Bear right at the stop sign onto Heckenluber Road. After 1 mile you will reach a stop sign at Brysonia Road. Turn right on Brysonia Road. Go approximately two miles and turn left on Nawakwa Road. The camp entrance is approximately a half mile from Brysonia Road. It sits on both sides of the road.

***From Chambersburg:*** take Rt. 30 East towards Gettysburg. Approximately 3 miles beyond Caledonia, turn left onto Rt. 234 East; follow Take to Nawakwa Rd. (it's the first left after crossing over the Conewago Creek). Turn left onto Nawakwa Rd. Proceed about 2 and a half miles. The camp sits on both sides of the road.

***From Gettysburg:*** take Rt. 30 West to Herr's Ridge Road. Make a right onto Herr's Ridge and travel approximately 1 mile to Mummasburg Road. Make a left; follow Mummasburg Rd. in to Arendtsville. At the stop sign in Arendtsville, turn left. At the next stop sign, turn right following Rt. 234 West. Just outside of Arendtsville turn right onto Brysonia Road. Go approximately four miles and turn left on Nawakwa Road. Travel a half mile. The camp sits on both sides of the road.
