Three-Tiered Pricing

LCC believes all kids should have the opportunity to attend camp. We know camp families have differing abilities to pay, so we offer a voluntary three-tier pricing structure to better meet all financial needs. Since you know your family's financial situation better than we do, you self-select the rate you can afford!

- **Tier 1:** Most closely reflects the "true cost" of camp.
- **Tier 2:** Partially subsidized for families needing some support to make camp affordable.
- **Tier 3:** Subsidized rate, supported through contributions from individuals and congregations.

PLEASE REMEMBER: All campers receive the same high quality camp experience regardless of payment tier chosen. Your selection is completely confidential.

Accredited by the American Camp Association

Both camps are accredited by the American Camp Association (ACA). ACA Accreditation means that the camp you are considering for your child cares enough to undergo a thorough (up to 300 standards) review of its operation - from staff qualifications and training to emergency management. Accreditation is a parent's/guardian's best evidence of a camp's commitment to health and safety.

LUTHERAN CHURCH CAMPING in Central Pennsylvania is an extension of congregational ministry in the unique setting that our camps provide. Children, youth, and adults learn, worship, witness, and serve within a Christ-centered Lutheran tradition.

CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS can participate in many of our programs. Camp staff need to know the nature of the child's special needs before arrival in camp. Please contact the camp of your choice for further information.

CAMPERSHIP APPLICATIONS are available for those whose families cannot afford the full camp fee. Campership applications may be obtained by contacting the Camping Office or on the website. Send in the Campership Application with your registration.

INSURANCE: Secondary coverage for health and accident is provided for all campers. Terms and benefits are available upon request.

HEALTH AND SAFETY: All campers are required to submit a completed medical form. This form is provided with the registration confirmation and is always available at LutheranCamping.org. A health

officer is always in camp during summer programs. Medical facilities are easily accessible from both camps. Lifeguards provide guidance at all our swimming pools.

CAMP STAFF provide outstanding leadership at all camps. High school and college students, teachers, nurses, seminarians, and pastors all contribute toward the Christ-centered communities that gather together each week.

VISITORS: The camping week is a very short period away from home. It is best if children are not visited by parents, friends, and relatives except in unusual circumstances. All visitors must obtain permission from the director to be in camp.

REFUND POLICY: Fees will be refunded for emergency or medical reasons only.

AGE GROUPS are based on grade completed in Spring 2025.

KIRCHENWALD/NAWAKWA CAMP WEEK: Each camp week begins Sunday with check-in between the hours of 3:00 and 4:30pm. Early check-in is not possible. Parents/Guardians may pick up their children on Friday evening between 6:30pm and 7:00pm.

CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT	<p>Our goal for each child attending a summer camp program is to have an experience of Christian community in which the camper is safe, and grows spiritually and socially. During a week in camp, in the course of activities, it is natural that there will be conflicts within cabin groups and between campers and their counselors. It is in resolving these conflicts – in the give and take of negotiation – that some of the most important lessons of a week at camp are learned.</p> <p>Occasionally, however, behavior on the part of a camper may become so disruptive as to require removal from a week of camp because conflicts cannot be resolved. Therefore, the following guidelines are presented for children during their week in camp. Parents/Guardians are encouraged to review these guidelines with their children.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Use language appropriate for Christian community.2. Respect the rights, privacy, and property of others.3. Respect the property and facilities of the camp.4. Wear appropriate clothes for activities as suggested by camp staff.5. Follow camp schedule (mealtimes, lights out, etc.).6. Do not engage in any acts of physical, sexual, or verbal abuse (camper/camper or camper/staff).7. Abide by the rules and regulations of the camp.8. Possession of alcohol or any illegal substance is prohibited.9. Campers are encouraged to participate in all camp activities to the best of their ability.10. Campers may leave their cabin group only with the permission of the cabin counselor. <p>CAMPER: In signing this section, I agree to abide by all regulations governing personal conduct and use of camp property. I am aware that I am expected to cooperate and participate in camp activities.
