<u>Job Definition</u>: Responsible for the supervision of all aquatic activities and aquatics personnel.

Professional Qualifications:

- 1. 21 years of age.
- 2. Previous experience in a supervisory position of a similar aquatic area.
- 3. Holds or has held one of the following certifications: WSI, Aquatic Instructor BSA, YMCA Instructor in lifesaving or swimming, or Lifeguard Instructor American Red Cross.

Personal Qualifications:

- 1. Personal commitment to Jesus Christ.
- 2. Desire to serve the church through the camping ministry.
- 3. A willingness to give a Christian witness through the activities of the camp.
- 4. An understanding of and agreement with the goals and objectives of the Lutheran Camping Corporation of Central Pennsylvania and the camping ministry of the ELCA.
- 5. An understanding of and agreement with the teachings and confessions of the ELCA.
- 6. Emotional stability and maturity of judgment.
- 7. A love and understanding of others.
- 8. Good health.
- 9. An appreciation for the camp setting.
- 10. Ability to teach and supervise others.
- 11. Ability to put the needs of others above personal needs.

Performance Responsibilities:

- 1. Supervise all areas of pool operation:
 - a. Cleaning
 - b. Maintenance
 - c. Activities
 - d. Pool personnel
 - e. Ordering of supplies

- 2. Canoeing Program
 - a. Teaching fundamentals of canoeing
 - b. Maintenance of equipment
 - c. Inspection of lake
