- 6. Help prepare and clean up for all cookouts.
- 7. Help in other camp activities when needed and if schedule allows, i.e.-registration, camp store, and worship.
- 8. Report to camp on Sunday by 2:00pm. Staff is free to leave when kitchen duties are completed on Saturday.
